At our February membership meeting, the regular members present voted to approve the funds necessary to go forward with this work. Our Club Members will perform a portion of the work and Camp Electric will be contracted to complete the project. The total scope of work is expected to take between 5 and 6 weeks.

Fiscal year 2017 saw a huge expense in removing the "mud bags" from our parking area. If not for that cost, last year would show a significant year end positive cash flow. Treasurer's reports over the last 4 months have shown each month with positive cash flow!! This is due to ACH payments, Club Events, Queen of Hearts, and most importantly, your continued participation.
